



Autumn Stars Socks
Designed Exclusively for Fabric.com

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The Goods:

Needles: US size 2

Yarn: Regia Kaffe Fassett Design Line in Mirage Fire (229.5 yds/ 50 g)

Gauge: 12 sts by 20 rows in 2 in. by 2 in.

Notions: Waste yarn, tapestry needle



This pattern is knit using magic loop

Using the waste yarn and Provisional Cast-on, cast on 24 sts.

Work a short row toe (see article in Knitty Winter 2002), leaving 6 unworked sts in the center and ending up with 48 sts total (24 on each needle)

Once toe cup is complete, knit one round

R1: {k5, pm, *k2, k2tog, yo, k3; repeat from * twice, pm, k5}, knit across second needle (bottom of sock)

R2: knit all sts

R3: {k5, *k1, k2tog, yo, k4; repeat from * twice, k5}, knit across second needle

R4-6: knit all sts

R7: {k5, *k3, yo, sl1, k1, psso, k2; repeat from * twice, k5}, knit across second needle

R8: knit all sts

R9: {k5, *k4, yo, sl1, k1, psso, k1; repeat from * twice, k5}, knit across second needle

R10-12: knit all sts

Repeat rounds 1- 12 until sock measures 7.5 in. then work across first needle (keeping in pattern and make note of which round you are on), on the second needle work a short row heel (same as short row toe) but leave 10 unworked sts in the center. Once heel is complete pick back up where you left off (see note from above)

Repeat rounds 1-12 repeating between { } on both needles so eyelet pattern is on the front and back until sock measures 6 in. from bottom of heel (about 4.5 in. of pattern worked).

Work 1 in. of 2x2 ribbing. Bind off using “Jen’s Surprisingly Stretchy Bind-off” (see Knitty Fall 2009)

Repeat for second sock
