


Noel Cable Cowl

The Goods:

Needles: size 9 US

Yarn: Nashua Isabella in Garnet (60% wool, 30% silk, 10% viscose), 2 skeins

 \bigcirc auge: 27 sts by 26 rows in 4 in. by 4 in.

Finished measurements: 12 in. W by 8 in. L

Notions: Two cable needles, Tapestry needle,
Row counter

Notes: 9 st LPC- sl 3 sts to cn and hold in fronts, sl next 3 sts to second cn and hold in back. K3, p3 from second cn, k3 from first cn

 $s2kp-Slip\ 2$ sts, k1, pass 2 slipped sts over knitted st



Cast on 120 sts and join for working in the round (being careful not to twist)

R1, 2, 3, 4, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 14, 15, 16: *P3, k3*, repeat to end of round

R5: *P3, (k3, p3) twice, 9 st LPC*, repeat to end of round

R13: *P3, 9 st LPC, (k3, p3) twice*, repeat to end of round

Repeat Rounds 1-16 until piece measures 6 in.

Increase Round: *K5, kf&b*, repeat to end of round (140 sts), turn to begin lace

R1: *K1, yo, k2tog, yo, k3, s2kp, k3, yo, ssk, yo*, repeat to end of round (you will need to rejoin for knitting in the round since you turned at the end of the last row)

R2 & all even rounds: knit

R3: *K1, yo, k2tog, k1, yo, k2 s2kp, k2, yo, k1, ssk, yo*, repeat to end of round

R5: *K1, yo, k2tog, k2, yo, k1, s2kp, k1, yo, k2, ssk, yo*, repeat to end of round

R7: *K1, yo, k2tog, k3, yo, s2kp, yo, k3, yo, ssk, yo*, repeat to end of round

Loosely bing off, weave in ends seam up lace turning hole if needed. Wet block to open up cables and lace. You can wear your Noel Cowl with the cables facing out with the purl side of the lace covering your shoulders or with the lace folded over the top of the cable so both rightsides are facing out. Both are gorgeous and show off the cables and lace wonderfully.
